The Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, in and for Lee County, at the FALL Term thereof, in the year of our Lord Two Thousand and Twelve, having been impaneled and duly sworn to inquire, upon their oaths do present that **Dustin D. Jaye**, in the County of Lee and the State of Florida, did:

COUNT I
FIRST DEGREE MURDER

On or about 24 July 2012, in Lee County, Florida, Dustin D. Jaye did unlawfully, from a premeditated design to effect the death of a human being, to wit: Debra Striano; or while engaged in the perpetration of, or in the attempt to perpetrate a burglary or robbery, kill and murder Debra Striano, by cutting her throat with a deadly weapon, to-wit: a knife or other sharp instrument, contrary to Florida Statutes 782.04(1); 777.011,

COUNT II
FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY WHILE ARMED

On or about 24 July 2012 in Lee County, Florida, Dustin D. Jaye did unlawfully enter or remain in a certain structure, to-wit: a house, located at or in the vicinity of 17691 Oakmont Ridge Circle, Fort Myers, Florida, in the County and State aforesaid, the property of Debra Striano or Russell Myers, as owner or custodian thereof, with the intent to commit an offense therein, to-wit: theft, and in the course of committing said

burglary the defendant was armed, or did arm himself within said structure with a dangerous weapon, to-wit: a knife or other sharp instrument, contrary to Florida Statute 810.02;777.011,

COUNT III
CRUELTY TO ANIMALS

On or about 24 July 2012 in Lee County, Florida, Dustin D. Jaye did unlawfully and intentionally commit an act or acts to an animal which resulted in the excessive or repeated infliction of unnecessary pain or suffering, or caused the same to be done, contrary to Florida Statute 828.12; 777.011

all being against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
