**COUNT I**  
**FIRST DEGREE MURDER**

On or about January 17, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully from a premeditated design to effect the death of a human being, or while engaged in the perpetration of a robbery, or the attempt to perpetrate a robbery, kill and murder Thomas Hunter, a human being, by actually possessing and discharging a firearm and shooting him, and the death of the said Thomas Hunter was the result of the discharge of the firearm, contrary to Florida Statutes 782.04(1); 775.087,

**COUNT II**  
**FIRST DEGREE MURDER**

On or about January 17, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully from a premeditated design to effect the death of a human being, or while engaged in the perpetration of a robbery, or the attempt to perpetrate a robbery, kill and murder Christopher Hunter, a human being, by actually possessing and discharging a firearm and shooting him, and the death of the said Christopher Hunter was the result of the discharge of the firearm, contrary to Florida Statutes 782.04(1); 775.087,

**COUNT III**  
**ROBBERY WITH A FIREARM, CAUSING DEATH OR GREAT BODILY INJURY**

On or about January 17, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully take away from the person or custody of Christopher Hunter, certain property, to-wit: a wallet or phone, the property of Christopher Hunter, as owner or custodian, with the intent to permanently or temporarily deprive the owner or custodian of a right to the property, by the use of force, violence, assault or putting in fear, and in the course of committing said robbery, did actually possess and discharge a firearm, and as a result of the of the discharge of the firearm, death or great bodily harm was inflicted upon a person, to wit: Christopher Hunter, contrary to Florida Statutes 812.13;775.087,

**COUNT IV**  
**ATTEMPTED PURCHASE OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE**

On or about January 17, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully attempt to purchase a controlled substance, to-wit: Oxycodone or Hydromorphone, contrary to Florida Statutes 893.13(2)(a);777.04,

**COUNT V**  
**POSSESSION OF FIREARM, AMMUNITION, OR CONCEALED**  
**WEAPON BY A CONVICTED FELON**

On or about January 17, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully, having been previously convicted of a felony, to-wit: Robbery, on or about August 19, 2016, in the Circuit Court of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit in and for Collier County, Florida, own or have in his actual possession, care, custody or control any firearm or ammunition, contrary to Florida Statutes 790.23(1)(a); 775.087,

**COUNT VI**  
**SHOOTING AT OR INTO AN OCCUPIED VEHICLE**

On or about January 17, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully, wantonly or maliciously, shoot a bullet or projectile from a firearm at, within, or into a vehicle, which at the time was being used or occupied by a person, to-wit: Thomas Hunter or Christopher Hunter, contrary to Florida Statutes 790.19,

**COUNT VII**  
**ARSON – SECOND DEGREE**

On or about January 18, 2017 in Collier County, Florida, did unlawfully and willfully, by fire or explosion, damage or cause to be damaged, a structure, to-wit: a Mercury motor vehicle, located at or in the vicinity of 20th Avenue NW, Naples, Florida, contrary to Florida Statute 806.01(2),

and against the peace and dignity of the STATE OF FLORIDA.






